Seeking Applicants for First Leadership Union Class!

The City of Union Community Development Department in partnership with the Union Area Chamber of Commerce and the University of Missouri Extension is accepting applications for the first LEADERSHIP UNION program.

LEADERSHIP UNION is a community leadership program designed to ensure the continued improvement of the Union area by developing a network of leaders that possess a broader understanding of the needs and issues of the city and to increase commitment to community service and leadership. It is designed to give each participant working knowledge of our local government, education system, industrial and economic development, quality of life and volunteer opportunities.

Benefits include:

- An improved communications network among civic, business, social and education leaders
- Assistance to potential leaders in their development, accurately matching their skills and interests with the needs of Union, Missouri
- A leadership base with a diverse perspective, prepared to more effectively guide Union, Missouri into its future.

Cost for the 5 month program is \$275 and includes all program costs including meals and overnight retreat. Meetings are held monthly with graduation scheduled for mid-May. The program is open to adult members of the Union area (age 18 and over) who are interested in mak-

ing the City of Union a better place to live, work and play. Class size is limited to 25 and applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Completed applications are due by December 21, 2007.
